Musical Instrument Tuition for Children on Upper Site – September 2026

We would like all our pupils to have an opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument. The skills learned not only support a child's musical abilities, but also have an impact on their motor skills, literacy and numeracy.

This is a voluntary activity and not part of normal school music lessons. These lessons take place during the school day and consist of ten 30-minute lessons for which a payment of £62.50 per term must be made. If you are entitled to free school meals, you may be able to have help with the costs of lessons so please contact us to discuss this. Your only other expense may be some pieces of music from time to time and the cost of an instrument should you wish to hire one. We hold instruments in school that pupils are able to use during tuition sessions.

Our peripatetic music teacher Mr Muckle will deliver the lessons in school and will offer tuition in guitar (including ukulele and bass), keyboard (including piano) and drums (including djembe).
